



## Research Study in Fatty Acid Oxidation Disorders

### What is this study about?

Clinicians are studying the safety and tolerability for a new novel drug for the treatment of Fatty Acid Oxidation Disorders (FAOD). Participants with specific FAOD are being recruited to take part in this 12-week study.

### Who is eligible for this study?

You need to be 18 years or older with a confirmed diagnosis of FAOD, specifically CPT2, VLCAD, LCHAD, or TFP. You must be willing to remain on a stable diet throughout the study and be able to perform some exercise tests. Potential participants will also be screened based on other criteria for study inclusion.

### What will I be asked to do?

This study includes visits to the study site as well as home visits. You will need to take a daily oral dose of the study drug for the study period and participate in medical laboratory testing and surveys to answer questions about your health status.

### Will I be compensated for travel to the study location?

You will have to make 4 visits to the study site. Other tests can be done by a home visit nurse so there is no geographical restriction (participants are being recruited from all over the United States). You will receive compensation for your travel and hotel and will have access to a concierge service to assist you with these arrangements.
